Year 1 Learning Web - Term 2 2025

English

Students look at how characters in stories are shown using words and pictures. They relate the characters and events to their own experiences. Students are learning to write a story with characters and events.

Mathematics

Students read, make and order numbers to at least 120. They group one- and two-digit numbers in different ways including tens and ones and skip count in twos, fives or tens to count collections. Students add and subtract numbers within 20, using a variety of calculation strategies. They compare and order objects and events using length, mass, capacity and duration and communicating their thinking. Students describe the duration and sequence of events using years, months, weeks, days and hours.

French

Students learn French words and phrases to talk about their families.

The Arts

Music

Students learn to describe how the loudness, speed and timbre of the music is used to show feelings and ideas in a tune from a folk song. They learn to sing parts of the song by listening and copying.

Visual Art

Students learn about how and why people from different places and cultures create and enjoy art. They make their own visual artworks by trying out different materials and art-making techniques.

Central Idea & Key Concepts

Through the learning in two or more subjects, the students explore the following central ideas and key concepts.

Central idea: Previous generations help us understand the relationships between the past and present.

Key concepts: change, reflection

For some subjects the learning focus continues from Term 1 into Term 2, with the new learning focus starting in Term 2 Week 3.

Science

Student learning in this area occurred in Term 1 and is completed in the first two weeks of Term 2.

Humanities & Social Sciences

Students look at how families and daily life have stayed the same or changed over time. They learn to ask questions and gather information by looking at materials they are given. Students think about what the information means and talk about different points of view.

Technologies

Students explore how tools and equipment can be used safely to produce a class garden bed. They learn how food in the past has been prepared in different ways compared to modern multicultural/fusion Australian dishes. Students learn how to design balanced and healthy meals and evaluate designs based on personal preferences.

Health & Physical Education

Students practice running, jumping, and throwing through games and activities like those in track and field.
