Under this agreement for 2017 Brisbane Central State School will receive

\$212 410*

This funding will be used to

Increase numbers of students achieving National Minimum Standard (NMS) in NAPLAN to:

- 100% for reading and numeracy in year 3 and year 5 or have an Individual Learning Plan for students who do not achieve NMS.

Increase the number of students in the Upper 2 Bands of NAPLAN in:

- Reading to 70% for Year 3 and 60% for Year 5;
- Numeracy to 50% for Year 3 and 55% for Year 5.

Our initiatives include

- Strengthen teacher knowledge and understanding of planning with Australian Curriculum in English and Mathematics and the implementation of high yield teaching strategies through collaborative planning sessions and coaching with Head of Teaching and Learning (Numeracy) and Literacy Coach (Literacy);
- Provide professional learning to develop a shared understanding and common language for student learning goals and embed feedback in the teaching and learning process through short term data analysis and case management cycles;
- Continue to build teacher capability regarding 'quality talk' using talk partners in classrooms and its place in supporting EAL/D learners;
- Engaging in Action Learning to deepen teacher knowledge and understanding of how to extend student learning through New Pedagogies: Deep Learning;
- Developing a whole school approach for the identification and extension of high performing students across all learning areas through the Advanced Learners Program.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Provide an increase in time to our EAL/D team (teacher and teacher aide) to support teachers in providing support for students where English is a Second Language. (\$56 248)
- Provide an increase in time for Intervention teacher to work with students to provide support for focused and intensive teaching. (\$56 240)
- Employ a 0.4 literacy coach to support staff in the teaching of literacy across the curriculum. (\$28 121)
- Employ a 0.4 teacher to work on our Advanced Learners Program. (\$28 121)
- Provide release time for teachers to analysing student achievement data and collaboratively plan to differentiate student learning and set aspirational goals for student learning. (\$40 000)
- Provide professional learning in coaching and implement a refined Personal Learning Framework to embed professional learning (\$13 000)
