- Levels of Achievement (LOA) – 95% of all students achieving a C or above in Mathematics
- NAPLAN – Writing (Year 3) - 60% of students achieving Upper 2 Bands
- NAPLAN – Writing (Year 5) - 40% of students achieving Upper 2 Bands.
